What is this product?	
Туре	Allspring (Lux) Worldwide Fund (the "Fund") is a Societe d'Investissement à Capital Variable (SICAV) composed of several separate sub-funds organised under the laws of Luxembourg.
Term	The Fund has been established for an indefinite period of time. The PRIIP Manufacturer reserves the right to liquidate the Fund, subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
Objectives	Allspring (Lux) Worldwide Fund - U.S. All Cap Growth Fund (the "Sub-Fund") seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing at least two-thirds of its total assets in equity securities of U.S. companies of any size, and up to 25% of its total assets in equity securities of non-U.S. issuers through ADRs, CDRs, EDRs, GDRs, IDRs and similar depository receipts as well as U.S. dollar-denominated equity securities of non-U.S. issuers. U.S. equity securities are securities issued by companies with their principal office in the United States or exercising a predominant part of their economic activities in the United States. The Sub-Fund promotes environmental and/or social characteristics but does not have a sustainable investment objective. The Sub-Fund may invest in any sector, and at times it may emphasise one or more particular sectors. The Sub-Fund may use futures, forward contracts, options or swap agreements, as well as other derivatives, for hedging or efficient portfolio management purposes. Through the use of a negative screening process, the Sub-Fund seeks to exclude certain securities in accordance with its exclusion policy.
